

Ecosystem Management through Fire

Case studies of fire use in Tallgrass Prairie, Savannah and forested areas of Southern Ontario



Come join Tallgrass Ontario and the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources East Fire Region as we explore ecological and ecosystem benefits through the use of fire.

We will look at how private business, non-government and government bodies (provincial, federal and crown agency) are all working towards a common goal of ecological benefits through fire. Case study presentations will follow a field tour of public and private lands previously treated with prescribed burns in the Kitchener/Waterloo area.

Presentations will focus on the role of fire in tallgrass prairie, oak savannah and woodland areas of Southern Ontario. We will also look at research partnerships and how fire is being used to assist in the maintenance, restoration and long term availability of habitat for species at risk in Ontario.
